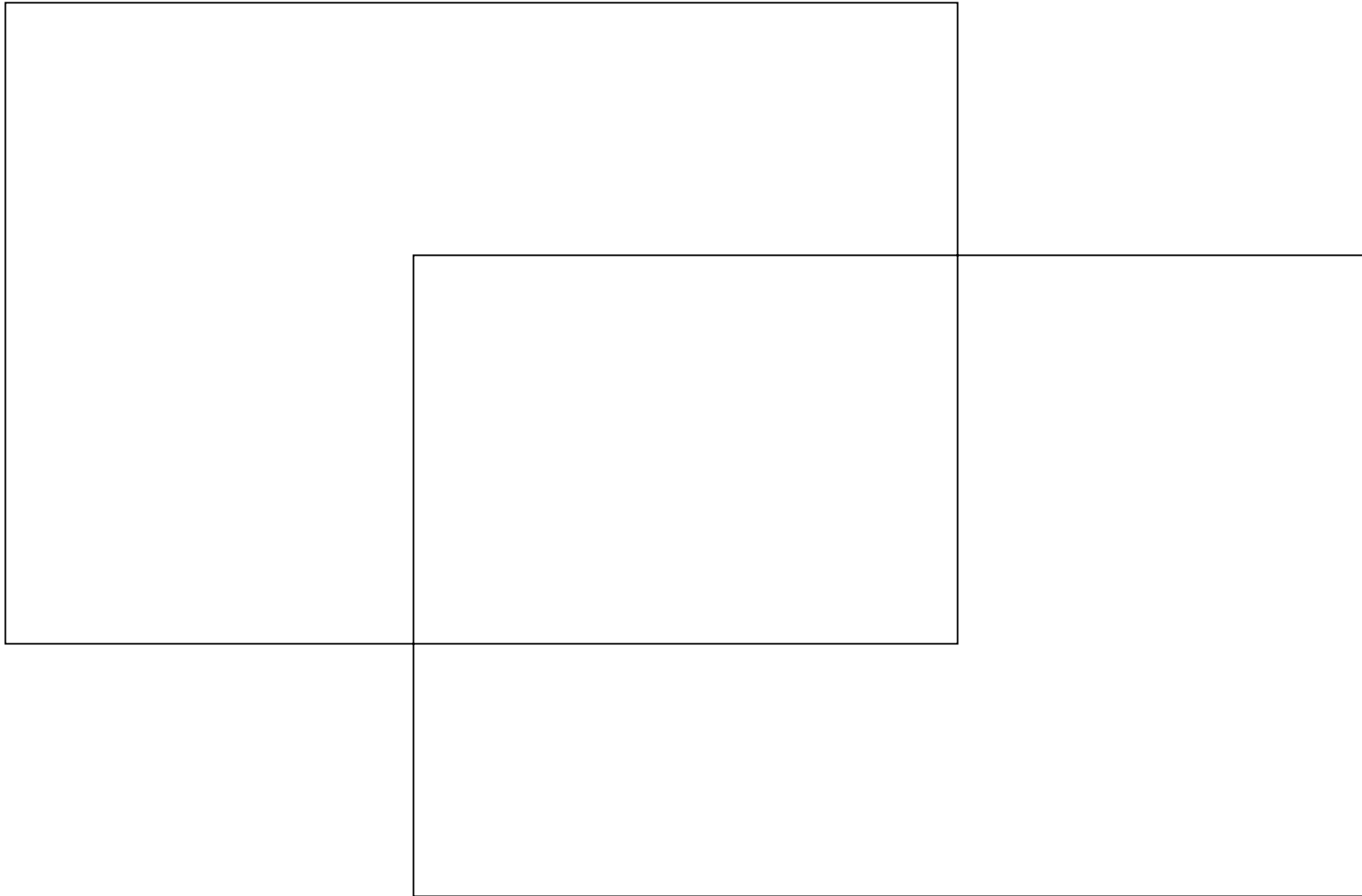


The Square Compare and Contrast Diagram
