1. “You’re off to great places”- Where do you think will you go?
2. “And YOU are the guy who’ll decide where to go”- Is this statement true? Who else could decide where you go?
3. What kind of streets will you go down? In town and out of town.
4. “And when things start to happen, don’t worry. Don’t stew. Just go right along. *You’ll* start happening to.”- Do the things that we do and the places we go define who we are as people?
