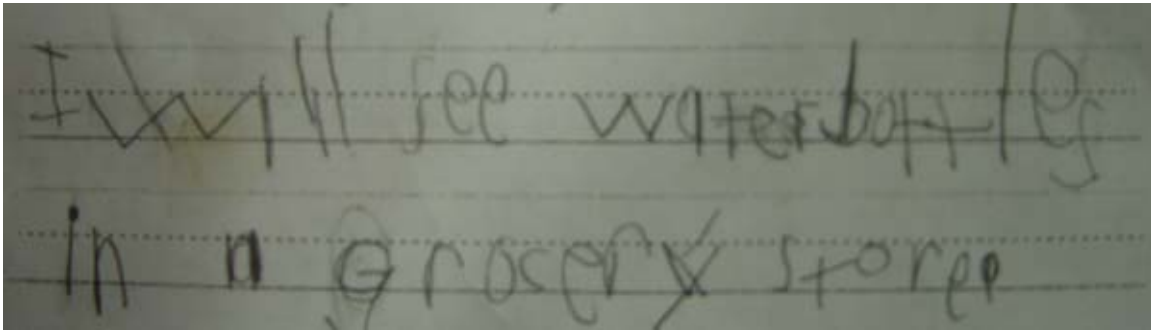


Second graders *start with what isn't there!*
