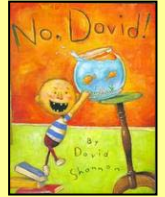

by Alex, first grade writer

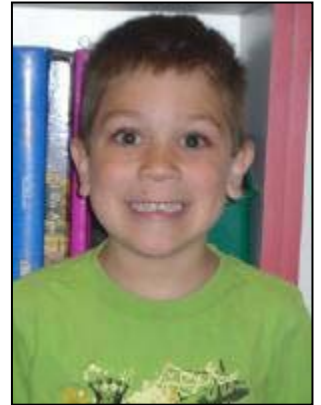
Luke Skywalker is a Jedi Knight. He protects the people!
