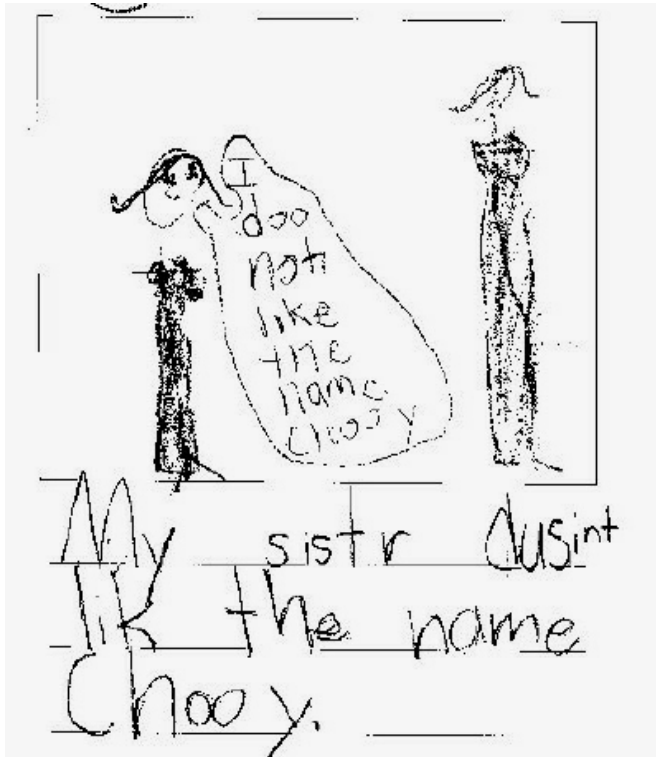
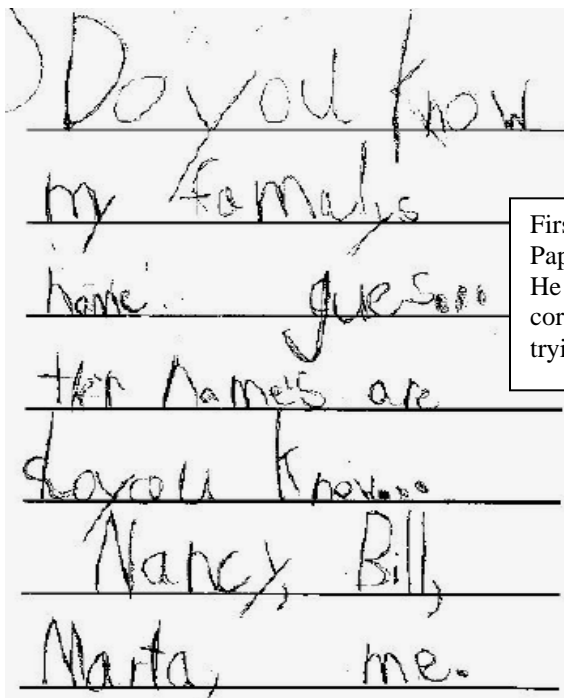


Student Samples from writing work in Unit 7.



McKenna uses a speech bubble as dialogue between characters and to reinforce the text of her story. The speech bubble reads, "I do not like the name Chewy." It's McKenna's sister who does not agree with the name.
